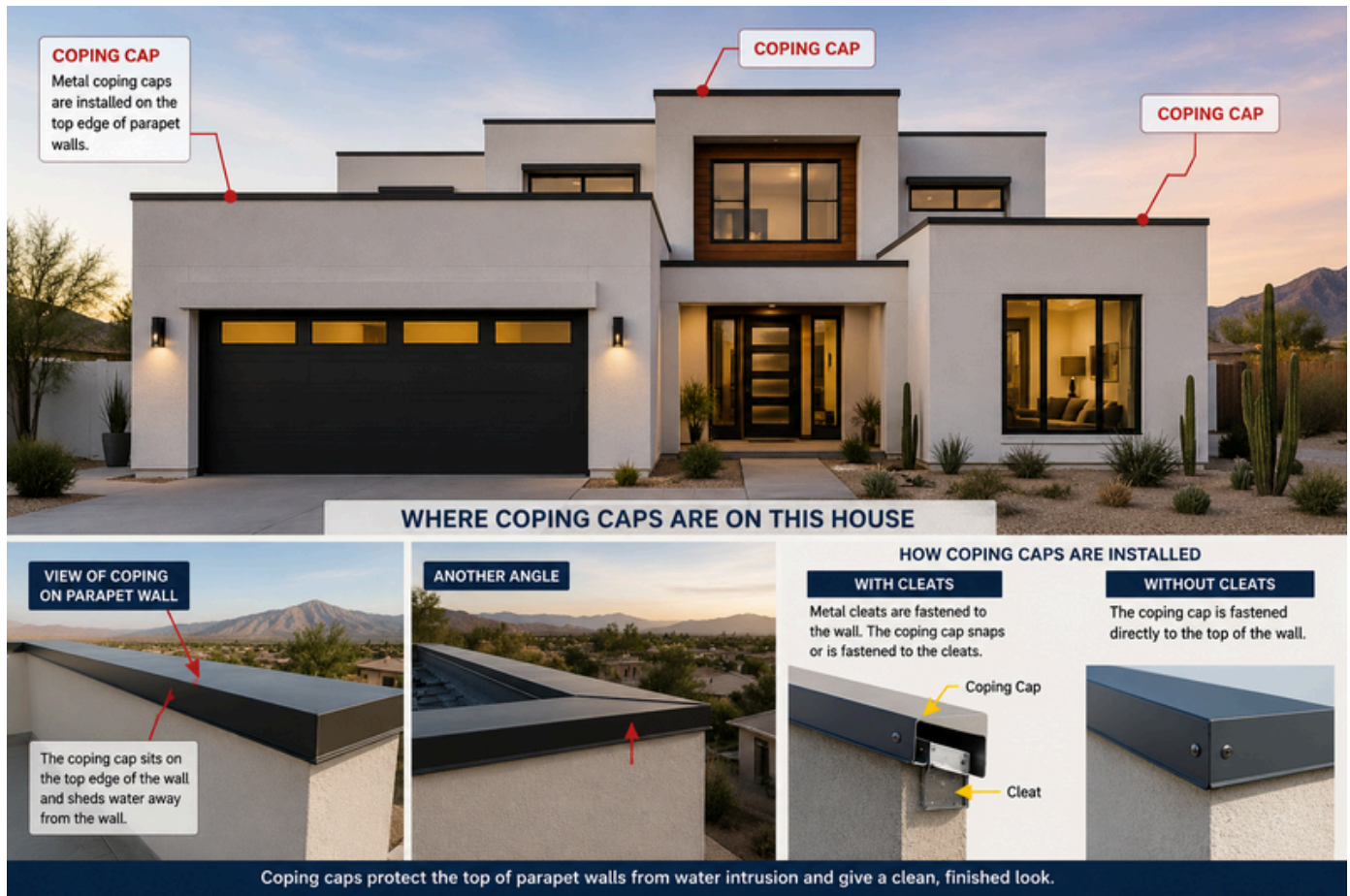


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WHAT IS A COPING CAP?



UNDERSTANDING COPING CAPS

Coping caps protect the top of parapet and perimeter walls from weather exposure while providing a clean, finished appearance. They are commonly installed using a cleated attachment system or fastened directly to the wall, depending on the roof design, wall conditions, wind exposure, and approved project requirements.

The graphic below shows where coping caps are located and provides a general comparison of cleated and non-cleated installation.

For a closer look at the available attachment methods, watch the video explaining three common systems:

- Single Cleat
- Double Cleat
- No Cleat
